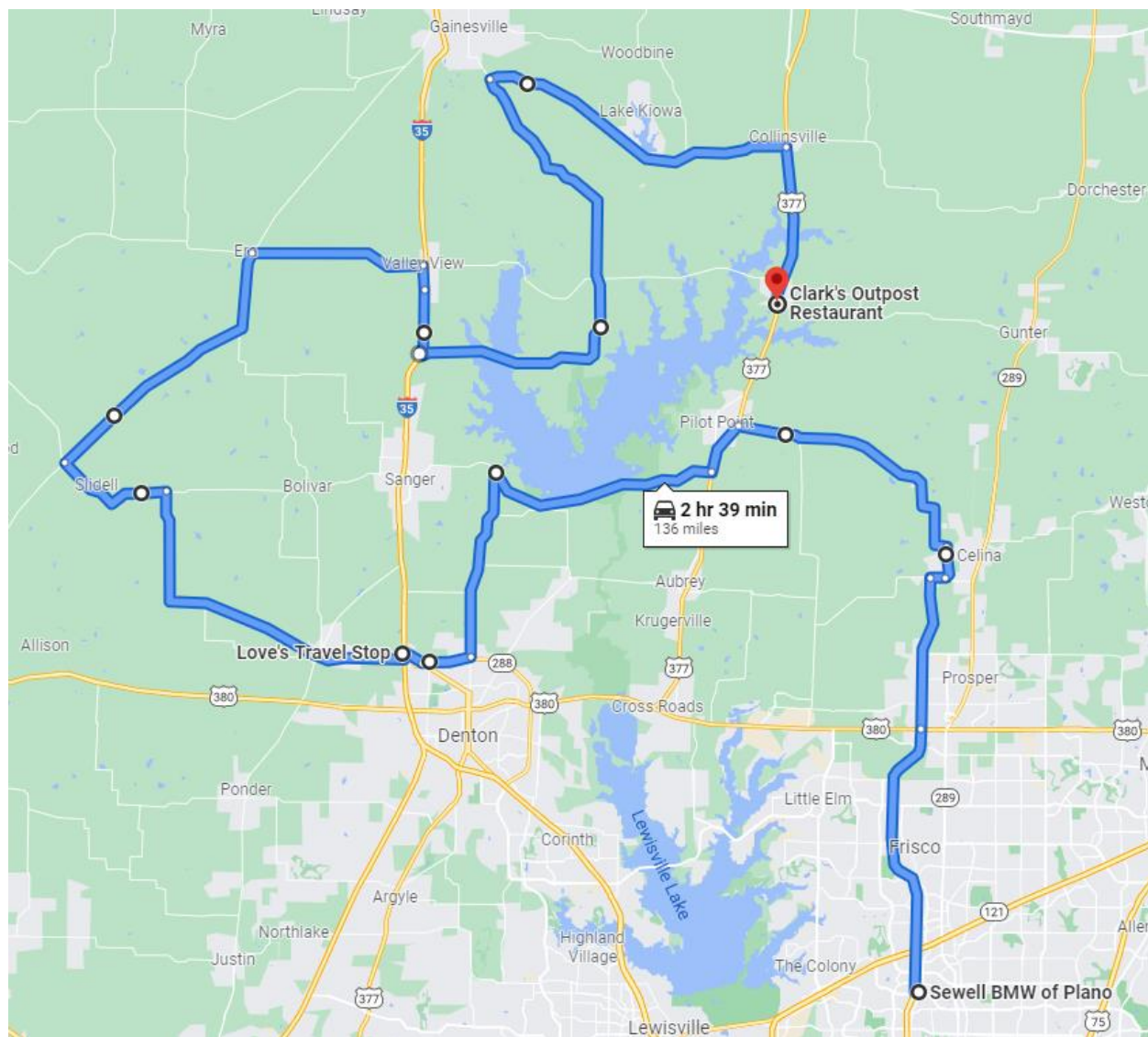

Distances are estimates and can be used to help with distance between turns

Pre-Drive Notes:

- Dallas Parkway appears to be starting to extend north of FM 428 but was a field as of the pre-drive. Take a picture to say you were here before...
- Love's travel stop instead of the T/A Travel stop: The stop light is long to turn left under I-35, so if we make the turn and then make the stop, we have an easier time to roll out. Love's is a smaller parking area, sorry.
- In Valley View on FM 922, we will attempt to go East instead of turning South to FM 3002. I place FM 3002 on there because in 2 attempts, 2 different trains stopped at the R/R crossing for an extended period of time.

- If we go South on the service road of I-35, please note: There is an off ramp for County Road 248. CR 248 is a gravel road and it is hard to see the **pot hole** just as the gravel ends – it is on the right-hand side of the car
- FM 902 shows construction but the road is OK
- Clark's Parking is packed Gravel and/or sand. You are welcome to park on the street area to the north of the building.
