The answers presented here are accurate just before the rally's official run date. If you are reviewing this after that time, it is possible these clues have been moved or changed.

Parker City Hall

- 1. "Uncle Billy" came from <u>Mississippi</u> around 1850. (Found on a historical marker in the group of 3)
- 2. Amanda Jane a specifically-named child identifying where William was buried
- 3. After World War II the historical marker at the remanent of the Cotton Gin (along the dirt path)
- 4. 1943 the information board for the park identifies "The Barn" and the sentence was copied
- 5. '86 This plaque is located under a tree next to the city hall building
- 6. Parker City Hall was built <u>February 1983</u> (month & year) by Betty McMenamy, who served from <u>1973</u> to <u>2006</u> both elements of these clues are found on different plaques in the entry way to the City Hall area.
- 7. <u>50</u> population of Parker located on one of the 3 historical markers grouped together

Driving

- 8. Ranch Round-Up Visitor Center in cursive under the visitor center porch
- 9. Ballroom the name of the ballroom is Oil Barons Ballroom
- 10. Ewing identified on the navigation post near the ballroom and the entry to the ranch
- 11. Dallas CCTV Security Cameras an Adopt the highway sign just after you turn right
- 12. College Fund purple trucks found on the left side of the road stated they are for College Fund
- 13. Kings Bridge
- 14. <u>Honest Local Service.</u>com a little black sign just after the sub division Refrigeration, Local HVAC
- 15. <u>Storm-Ready</u> as you enter the city limits, there is a sign to the right of the city limits sign that says a "Storm-Ready" community
- 16. <u>Bait</u> the convenience store at the intersection shows "Sandwiches" and "Bait" is just under that statement
- 17. 1480 Coker this is a mailbox along this road with a name just under it.
- 18. Daytona Ave a street on the right-side of the road before you reach the bridge
- 19. Community Church Branch there is a bell just as you turn left onto FM-546
- 20. Green and White as you pass by the RV park, looking backward, you see the logo on a fence
- 21. <u>Barto</u> on the left side of the road, you reach a lot of construction equipment a large quantity of cement trucks
- 22. <u>Creative</u> Fabrication on a fence on the left side of the road just past a stone wall
- 23. <u>Simpson Strong Tie</u> training center on the right side of the road is the first training center you find
- 24. Encore Wire
- 25. RaceTrac
- 26. 2 the first sign showing New Hope after the turn is 2 miles to New Hope

- 27. 524 population size
- 28. Stone Crest event center found on the right side of the road
- 29. Jackie Don Miller large sign found on the left side of the road just before the Baptist church
- 30. <u>Dree's</u> on the right-side of the road just past the Baptist church, you see multiple home builder signs and the first is Drees
- 31. Stiff Creek
- 32. Trails of <u>1827</u> (there are two places with the same name one on the right and then one on the left)
- 33. Sumeer Homes
- 34. <u>Therapeutic Horsemanship Horses, Hope & Healing</u> on the left-side of the road you will come across a horse statue and will need to stop to see what it says
- 35. Valdasta a loop road you first see on the right-side of the road
- 36. Westminster is the first Blue Ridge/(City) sign you see after the previous clue
- 37. 3
- 38. Paradise Place yellow sign on the right side of the road as you enter Blue Ridge



39-42 - sign on the right-side of the road

- 43. Tigers look up on the water tower and see the Orange and White tiger
- 44. Rockin' little chicken place on the left side as you pass by the water tower

- 45. 9 miles to Lenore
- 46. Flying Tiger Field on the right-side of the road, you will see the name over the entry way
- 47. Taylor just after you turn left onto FM-815, it tells you Beth adopted this section
- 48. 4-Wheel Dr over the top of the residence, you will find the name
- 49. Bluebonnet Meat Market name of a business on the right side of the road as you enter Trenton

Trenton

- 50. The Hitch'n Post a closed building on the right as you reach the War memorial
- 51. <u>Steven Ray Haden</u> only name listed for that specific war on the memorial
- 52. WW I
- 53. A Simpler Time the text at the bottom of the mural found on the North East building
- 54. Wildcat Thicket historical marker on the square identified this name for the community

Driving

- 55. TXB: We are Texas Born displayed on the convenience store at the intersection of US-69 and TX-121
- 56. Texan RV Park
- 57. Skydive Dallas
- 58. 1604 first population sign for Whitewright
- 59. Tractor Pullers hard to read sign at the intersection of US-69 and FM-110
- 60. Helena Chemical Co
- 61. Texas-New Mexico Power Company red brick building on the right side of the road
- 62. Red and Farmall great little picture area
- 63. Butler is written on the silo's name

Savoy

- 64. Grizzly Burger House
- 65. The Bird's Nest
- 66. <u>1956</u> you can find the cornerstone with the dedication on the shopping side of the buildings where Grizzly Burger House is located.





67. $\underline{\text{Sunny Side}}$ – on the right as you start the curve toward US-82

68. Quilting

- 69. <u>United Methodist</u> sign on the left side of the road at a T-intersection shows Hebron Baptist is down the road but this field is labeled as being owned by the United Methods.
- 70. <u>Bell/Savoy</u> there are multiple NTX sand pits in this area but this is the first one when you make the right turn.
- 71. <u>2645</u> you will see a blue sign identifying the Texas Lakes Trail and then an intersection with FM-2645
- 72. Johnson a lot of cemeteries out here but this one appears just after the Mt Zion one.
- 73. <u>209</u>
- 74. Pine St
- 75. N-Tex Wolf Creek Plant on the right side of the road
- 76. 7
- 77. Boyd Baptist Church on the right
- 78. Two RV park on the left almost across from the Baptist church



79. Kampers – convenience store on the left as you get stopped by the stop light at this intersection.

Fanin County Courthouse

- 80. Cotton Mill look to the north side of the Plaza to find the different names of 1 business
- 81. Latin restaurant You can see this on the East side of the Plaza
- 82. 1888 displayed over the center of each side of the courthouse and in the cornerstone
- 83. <u>1982/Anderson Roberts</u> found on the memorial details on the Northeast corner
- 84. Steamboat historical marker on NE corner

- 85. <u>Constantine/12</u> cornerstone on the North East section of the building. Did you see County Judge Greta L. (Spanky) Carter II and also that there is a Time Capsule buried 3/10/2022 not be opened for 100 years?
- 86. 100 years of Texas Independence his statue is on the Southeast corner of the plaza.
- 87. Alamo found on the Historical Marker on the Northeast corner
- 88. South Carolina and Montgomery Alabama
- 89. <u>270,000</u> difficult to read, but located on the back of the Confederate memorial on the Northwest section of the court house grounds.

Driving

- 90. 411 <u>Fannin Land</u> is a business on the West side of the Plaza and related to the address but is probably a real estate office
- 91. Green
- 92. <u>Auction and Real Estate</u> on the left side it appears to have construction equipment on site but kept the Drive In tower.
- 93. 1895 to 1905 found on the historical marker just past the Ely sign
- 94. Rocking K Ranch a small white sign next to the 2-story building just after the turn off to Savoy
- 95. Triple R BBQ little BBQ place on the right side of the road
- 96. 7 miles to Ida
- 97. Coker again with the Coker
- 98. 43,645 is the population of Sherman according to this sign just before Tx-10
- 99. 2 the left-hand side on airport property identifies as Fire Station #2
- 100. Hope on Houston a Mission in the area. Thought the saying sounded nice
